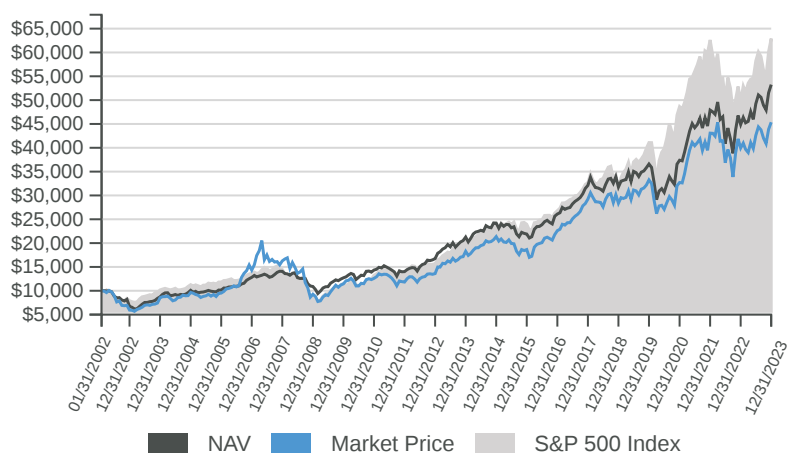

Under the Managed Distribution Policy, the Fund intends to make quarterly distributions at a constant and fixed (but not guaranteed) rate, which rate is subject to change at the discretion of the Fund's Board of Directors. Distributions are paid from ordinary income; net realized short-term capital gains; net realized longterm capital gains; and return of capital, or some combination of the aforementioned. A return of capital may occur for example, when some or all of the money that you invested in the Fund is paid back to investors. A return of capital distribution does not necessarily reflect the Fund's investment performance and should not be confused with 'yield' or 'income.' Based on current estimates, we anticipate the most recent distribution has been paid from ordinary income, short-term capital gains; long-term capital gains; and a return of capital. If a distribution includes anything other than net investment income, the Fund provides a Section 19(a) notice of the best estimate of its distribution sources at that time, available at SRHTOTALRETURNFUND.COM. The actual amounts and sources of the amounts for tax reporting purposes will depend upon the Fund's investment experience during the remainder of its fiscal year and may be subject to changes based on tax regulations. These estimates may not match the final tax characterization (for the full year's distributions) contained in shareholders' 1099-DIV forms after the end of the year, which will tell you how to report these distributions for federal income tax purposes.
